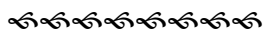

NSW Primary School Winners of the 2015 Anzac Day Schools Award

Last Friday Senator the Hon. Marise Payne, Senator for Western Sydney and Minister for Defence visited our school to present Year 6, **Mrs. Rose, Mrs. Hastings and Mrs Kersivien** with an Anzac Day Schools' Award. Year 6 were the State winners in this competition. This is the fourth time in as many years St. John Vianney's has won this award.

"I congratulate the St. John Vianney's Parish Primary school community on being awarded yet another Anzac Day Schools' Award. It is an important honour and one that students, teachers and parents should be very proud of," Senator Payne said.

"It is a wonderful achievement to win four of these awards and I'm delighted to visit the school once again to recognise the efforts of the students and teachers."

"This year's award recognises the school's commitment to teaching students about Australia's wartime history through its excellent program that focuses on the role of animals in wartime and especially the horses used by the Australian Light Horse Brigade"
